

SUPPLY LIST FOR 7-12 GRADE STUDENTS- 2008/2009

All 7th-12th grade students are required to provide a thumb drive to save any work that they will do on a school computer.

Students are **not** allowed to save any work on a school computer and will only be allowed to use school printers in emergency situations (printing request needs to be communicated by a parent: students will be charged at the rate of \$.10 per page).

HIGH SCHOOL SUPPLIES

SPANISH I-1V:

1-3 Subject notebook (**no** loose-leaf paper);
1 Spanish/English dictionary;
one 70-page notebook for journal (*Spanish II-IV only*),
blue or black pens,
1 box of Kleenex.

CHEMISTRY/ BIOLOGY: A two pocket folder and a spiral notebook that has perforated pages OR a three ring binder with a two pocket folder and loose-leaf paper.

PHYSICS/PHYSICAL SCIENCE: Calculator w/square root function (the calculator required for math is fine, but has more functions than will be needed for physics)

WORLD HISTORY (9), U.S. History (10) & Civics (11):

Colored pencils (**only required for World History**),
multi-colored highlighters,
3 ring binder
loose-leaf paper.

WORLDVIEWS (12)

1" 3- ring binder;
multicolor highlighters;
loose-leaf paper (no spiral notebooks, please)

BIBLE (9-11):

NIV Bible,
pkg. 3X5 spiral bound note cards (for memory verses),
3-ring binder w/loose leaf paper **or**
spiral notebook w/pocket dividers for keeping homework.
Highlighters, pens
9th grade- bring a box of Kleenex

10th-12th grade ENGLISH: 3 ring binder or pocket folder (for English only), blue or black pens.

GEOMETRY

Spiral notebook for taking class notes (just for math),
loose-leaf notebook paper for daily assignments,
1 Box of "Kleenex" tissues.

Geometry instruments: ruler, compass, and 4" base protractor. (or an inexpensive set that contains these for about \$3).

Scientific calculator that has sine, cosine, tangent. The newer **TI-30X IIS** with 2-line display is highly recommended (~\$15 Back to School specials)

ALGEBRA 2, PRE-CALCULUS & CALCULUS STUDENTS - SUPPLIES

Spiral notebook for taking class notes (just for math),

loose-leaf notebook paper for daily assignments,

1 Box of "Kleenex" tissues.

Graphing calculator: **TI-83 PLUS or the new TI-84 PLUS.** The new Silver is faster, has more memory, and comes w/ computer cable but with a higher price tag. I do have an engraver so that the student's name can be engraved on the calculator. Calculators for use at school should **not** be programmed with games. (If questions please call Mrs. Behrends 352-5923.) Last summer several stores (Office Depot, Best Buy, etc.) had back-to-school specials of ~\$85 on the TI-83+.

Algebra IA & IB (Miss Rice):

One 1" 3-ring binder (to be used for math only);

5 dividers;

pkg. Loose-leaf paper;

spiral notebook;

ink pens (for grading);

lots of pencils;

eraser

book cover

box of tissues

Recycled paper is allowed but not recommended; a flat zipper pencil pouch is recommended but not required.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: All junior & senior high school students taking physical education will need to bring a pair of tennis shoes that will remain at school and only be used for indoor use (in the gymnasium).

SPEECH/DRAMA: All speech (and drama) classes need to have a pocket folder, yellow highlighter and plain sheets of paper to take notes on.

The senior high speech class needs to purchase a black & white composition book for journaling.
